



Highlights of the month

- NCPI (Base 2021=100) in July 2024 has decreased to 206.9 from 208.1 in June 2024.
- Month on Month change contributed by 0.22% from food and -0.79% from non-food.
- NCPI Core (Base 2021=100) in July 2024 has unchanged at 193.7 from June 2024.
- The general price level has increased by 106.9% compared to the index reference (2021)
